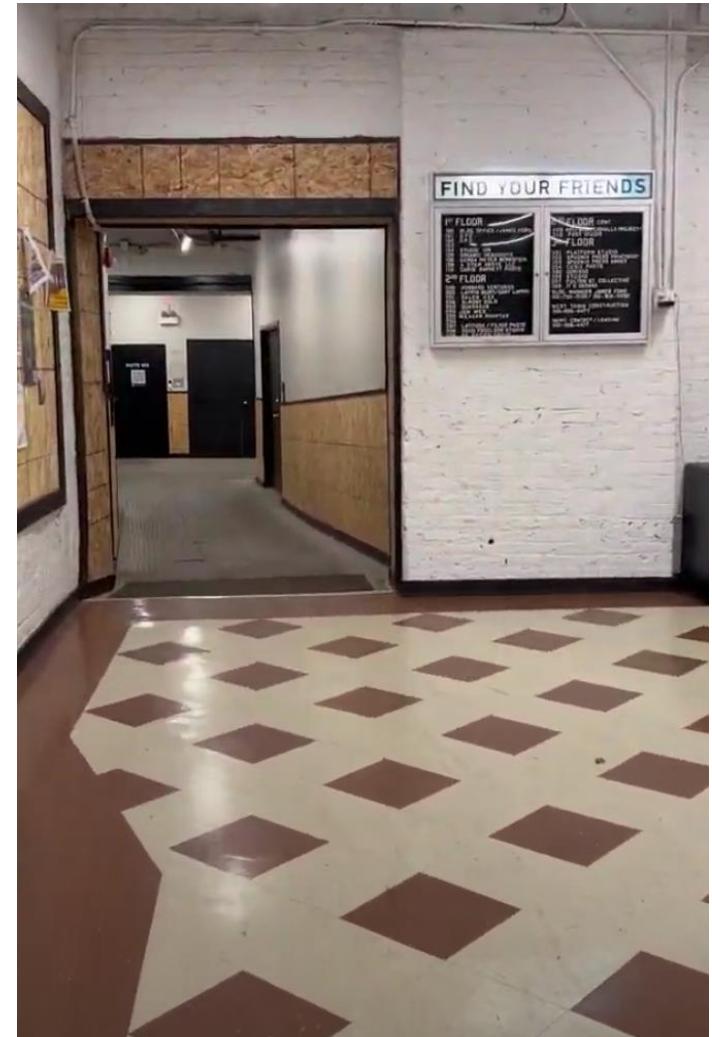

On Saturday, April 20, I will be attending a LYNX celebration event at 2pm at Fulton Street Collective.

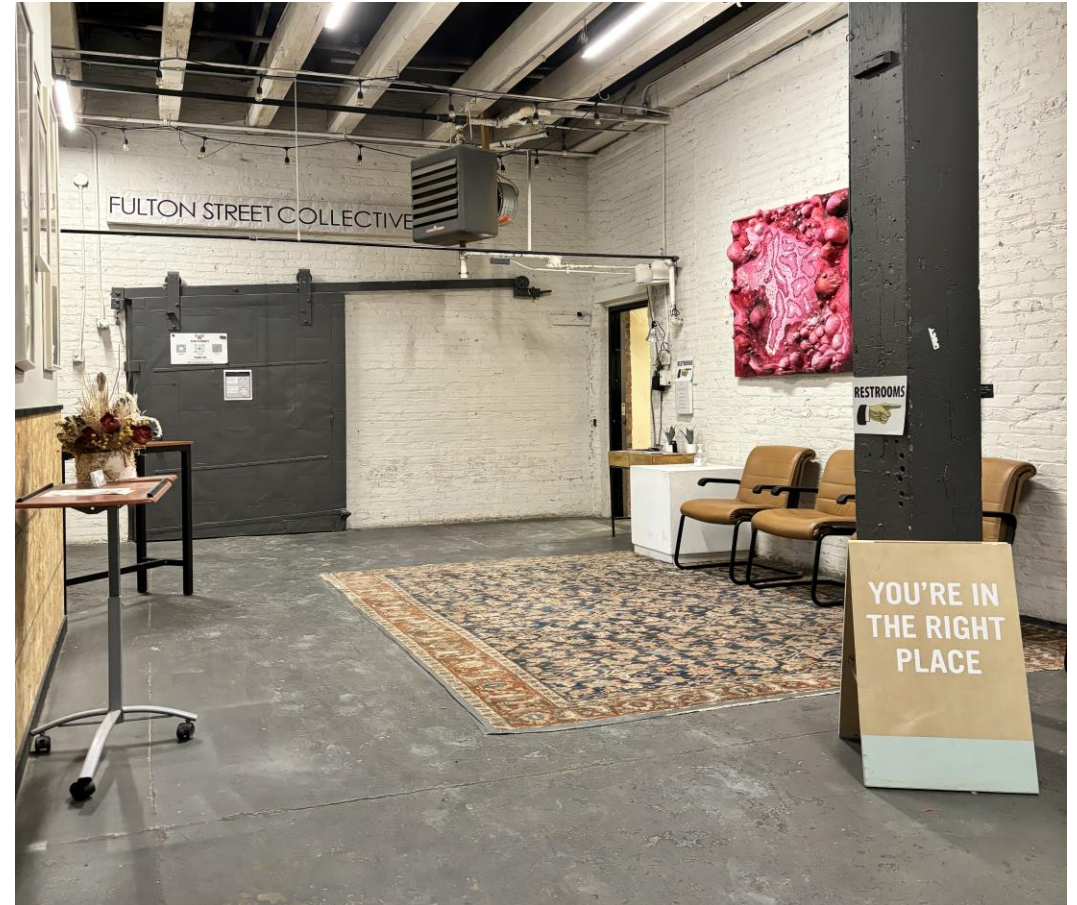

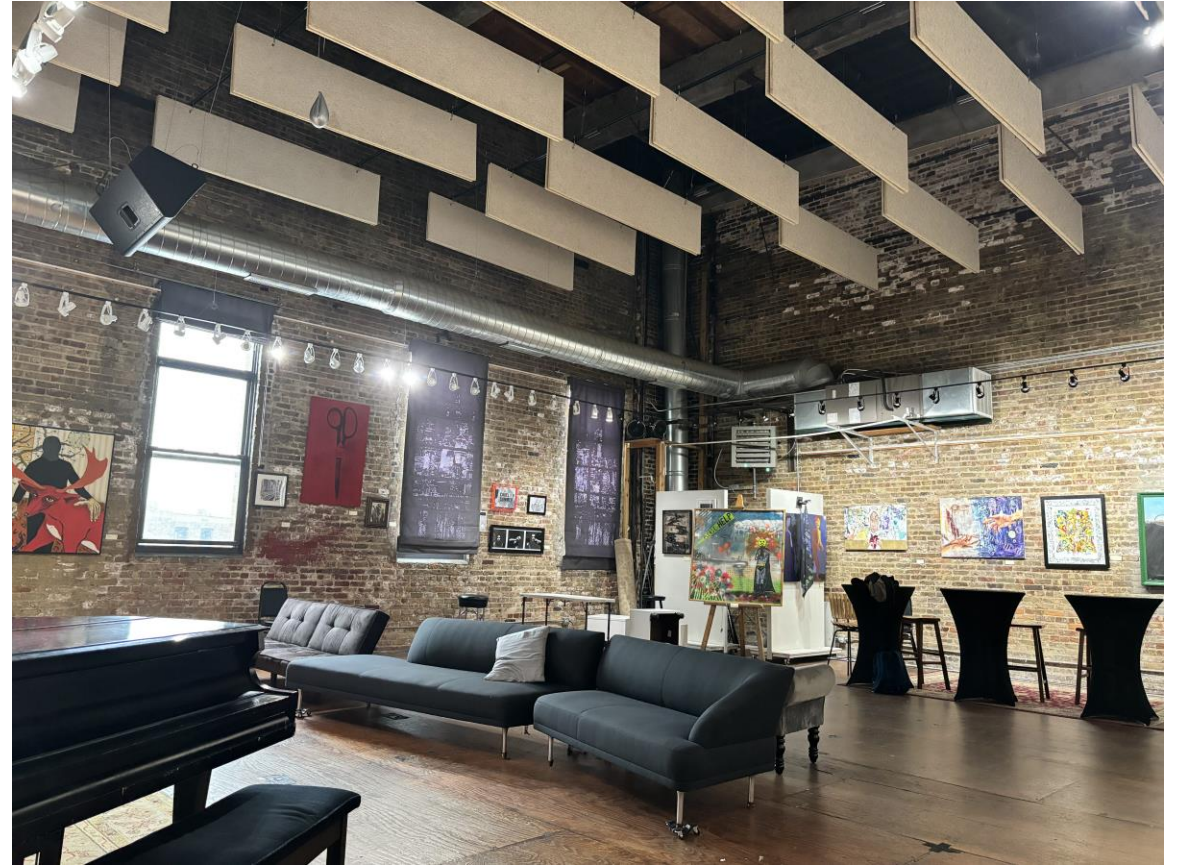
Once I arrive at the venue, I can walk through the hall towards the elevator (which will be on your right).



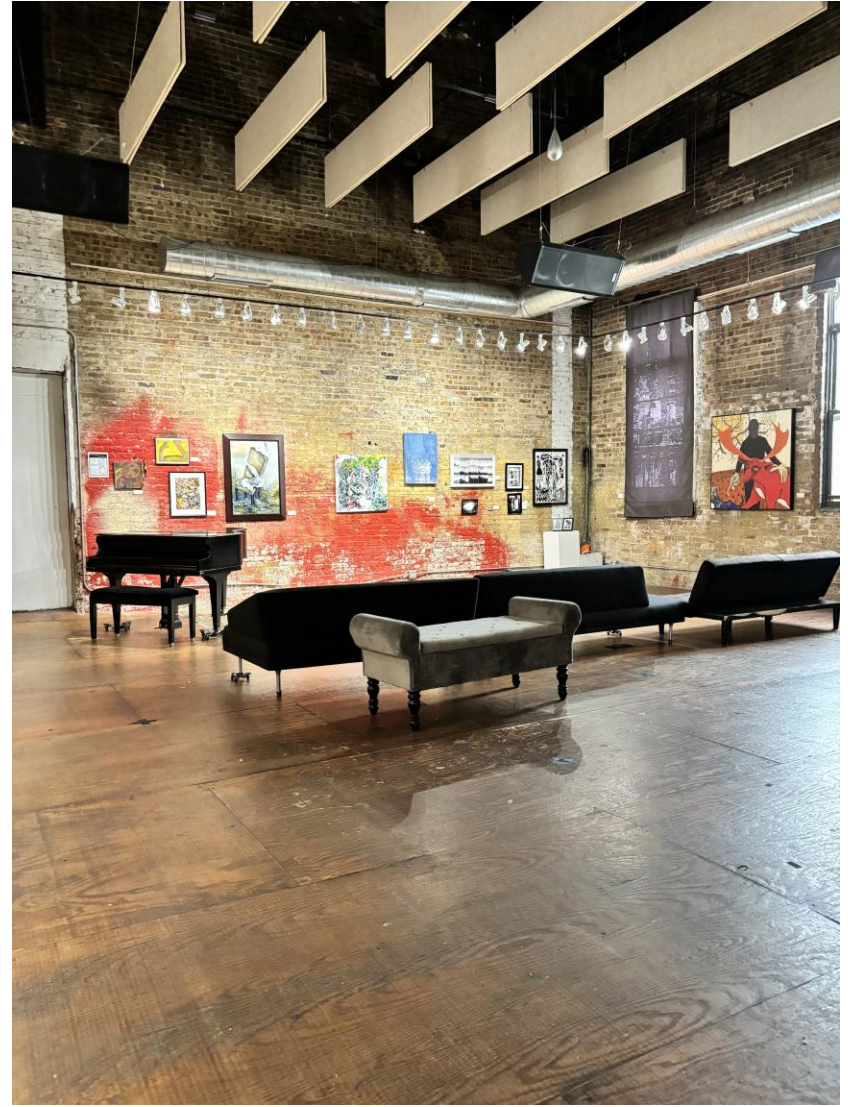
Fulton Street Collective

As I enter the venue, I will see the open space where the event will take place.



I can choose to sit on couches, chairs, or stand anywhere in the room.



This is a sensory friendly concert where I will be able to get up and move. I can feel comfortable in this space to make any sounds I need to and can exit the concert at any time. The sensory relief area will be set up in an art studio.



There will be speeches and performances. The music I will hear will be performed by a singer and pianist.

The singer's voice will be loud and soft at times, and they may sing high and low notes depending on the song.



During the concert, there will not be applause from the audience. Instead, we will wave our hands or snap our fingers to celebrate the concert. This will help cut down on loud noises such as clapping that can be hard to listen to.



There will be free food and drinks!



The event will be 3 hours long. From 2-3pm, there will be a social mingle. From 3-4:15pm, there will be speeches and performances. From 4:15-5pm, there will be a chance to continue with the social mingle.
